MELTON) (IMPOSITION OF 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (The Act) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose a 50 mph speed limit on various lengths of B676, Melton Road Burton on the Wolds, From Six Hills Lane to Melton Road, Hoby with Rotherby, Six Hills Lane, Broughton and Old Dalby Narrow Lane, Burton on the Wolds and Six Hills Road, Hoby with Rotherby and Paudy Lane, Seagrave
